 College-Wide Requirements Plan due on BiONIC

### **NOVEMBER IST OR JANUARY 17TH:**

 Draft of Resume due on Handshake (submit in Nov. for feedback before Winter Break)

### APRIL 15TH:

 Declare your Major by submitting your Major Work Plan on BiONIC

# **COLLEGE WIDE REQUIREMENTS:**

- ALL students are required to have their College-Wide Requirements done by the end of Junior Year.
- You must receive at least a 2.O in the class to satisfy a Approach to Inquiry (you may take a course C/NC)
- The 4 Approaches to Inquiry must be completed in different departments
- Only I course used to satisfy an Approach to Inquiry can count towards your major
- Each Approach to Inquiry must be fulfilled by a separate class
- All PE credits should be completed by the end of the Sophomore year this is a quideline, not a hard deadline!

## MAJOR ADVISORS:

A list of Major Advisors for each department can be found on Moodle - Your Major Advisor will need to approve your Major Work Plan for you to declare.

### MAJOR WORK PLAN:

Your Major Work Plan will be completed on BiONIC. The classes you enter into the Major Work Plan are not binding - they are to give you and your advisor a sense of the requirements you have to complete.

# DECLARING YOUR MAJOR:

Bryn Mawr students may declare their major at any point during their Sophomore year.

Students considering an independent or double major should consult their Dean.

## OTHER CONSIDERATIONS:

- Students planning to study abroad have until the end of their Junior year to complete College-Wide Requirements - students studying abroad in the spring should complete all requirements by the fall!
- Do not assume that courses taken while abroad will count towards your major!
  Consult with your majro advisor about creating a plan!
